Once a volunteer completes a series of short training sessions, the volunteer can decide and select an area of service that suits them.



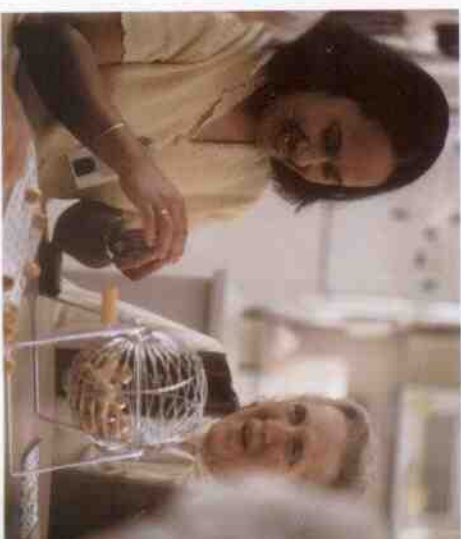
What is Karen Ann Quinlan Hospice?
